We believe God designed marriage to be a supportive, loving, life-giving relationship that reflects his unconditional love for us. God uses his church to tell his story, and strong marriages are essential to that mission.

Our Ministry

Re|engage is a discipleship-based enrichment ministry for every marriage—the healthy, the struggling, and the broken. It draws married couples to the church, giving them a safe place to move toward oneness through small groups, teaching, and stories of hope. Here, couples learn about God’s design for marriage and apply biblical principles for building a healthy relationship.



Curriculum

Simply put, the Re|engage curriculum is the gospel applied to marriage. The goal is not behavior modification; the goal is transformation. Therefore, the curriculum focuses on heart issues like grace, humility, brokenness, and forgiveness before tackling practical marriage tools like communication, conflict resolution, and sexual intimacy.

Churches Offering Re|engage

Re|engage is offered in over 700 churches across the United States.



Program Length

14-lessons completed over 4-6 months.



Audience

Designed for married couples, ages 18 and up, at any stage in their relationship.



Time Commitment

Includes a weekly 2-hour ministry night plus a weekly lesson to complete.



Ministry Model

Offered in semester or year-round formats. Each week includes teaching or testimony, followed by small group discussions centered on growth and vulnerability.

How is Re|engage Different?

Re|engage is more than a marriage class—it's a safe, gospel-centered environment where couples grow in relationship with God, each other, and the church community.

Better Together

Couples walk through Re|engage in small groups with 4–6 other couples, building authentic relationships through shared experiences and mutual support.

Authenticity

Re|engage promotes honest conversation, helping couples move beyond surface-level church life into the freedom of being fully known by others.

It's for Everyone

Every marriage has room for improvement. Whether a marriage needs to be reignited or completely resurrected, Re|engage is a safe place for couples to reconnect.

Builds Synergy

Stronger marriages benefit children and youth ministries, as parents model healthy, Christ-centered relationships at home.

Discipleship-Focused

Re|engage is often a side door into the church—drawing in couples through the pain of marital struggle to hear the gospel and begin the journey of discipleship.

Prevents Staff Burnout

Designed to lighten the load on staff, Re|engage equips lay leaders to walk alongside couples and care for marriages.

Financial Consideration & Start-up Requirements

Program Costs | There are no licensing fees to run Re|engage at your church, only the cost of workbooks. Most churches choose to pass these costs along to the participants, plus a small markup to cover ministry night expenses (childcare, commencement night, etc.).

Development Process

How to onboard Re|engage at your church.

1

Prepare for Change

Perform research to define your implementation plan. Evaluate how Re|engage aligns with your current culture, how it might impact other ministries and staff, and what resources are needed and available.

2

Facilitate a Pilot Group to Establish Leaders (about 6 months)

A pilot group creates leaders who are familiar with the curriculum before launch. Pilot groups are the start of establishing a safe culture church-wide.

3

Launch the Ministry at Your Church

Open Re|engage to your church. Publicize, redirect couples seeking help, work to create a vulnerable and authentic culture, and make your community aware of the resource.
